Funk was fun, fresh and furious, and so were we. We ran seminars at school assemblies on how to "give five" and do the Funky Chicken. On the strength of the slogan "Get the funk out of our face," we were elected president and vice-president of our class. Then, on the night of our victory party, George Clinton and Bootsy Collins appeared like a dream before us. They warned us that the funk would fade, and that it would be our duty to make the world a funkier place to live. Although we spoke not a word of this again, we knew that we were destined to start the '70s Preservation Society and release *Those Funky '70s*.

The songs on *Those Funky '70s* will change your life. Listen to the thumping bass on *Keep on Truckin'*, the syncopated horns on *Shining Star* and the scratchy guitar on *Tell Me Something Good* and you'll discover that funk has power and meaning that no mortal can comprehend. So if you can't get a date or you're staring at the ceiling of your office or you just wanna let go, turn on *Those Funky '70s*. Your limbs will loosen, your mind will clear and you will be sanctified.
